The next sitting of the Landscape Architect Registration Examination (L.A.R.E.) will be for multiple choice exams A, B, and D from September 12-25th. Register before August 19th, to get \$25 off your exam fee!

Scores from the June 2011 Vignette exams (C, E) will be posted online during the first week of September. The LARE is administered across North America only on dates established by CLARB (see www.clarb.org). The graphic sections of the exam are administered by the OALA in Ontario.
