INFRASTRUCTURE STIMULUS FUNDING “Solemn Declaration of Substantial Completion”

An OALA Member has brought to our attention an issue related to Infrastructure Stimulus Funded projects, through information he has received from Consulting Engineers of Ontario. CEO Members are being informed that they should NOT sign a “Solemn Declaration of Substantial Completion” if asked by their clients. Instead, they should use a template cover letter provided by the Ministry of Infrastructure. Members are urged to contact the Ministry for specifics.

2011 Ottawa Urban Design Awards

In 2011, the City of Ottawa will host the fourth edition of the Ottawa Urban Design Awards. www.ottawa.ca/urbandesignawards

The deadline for submissions [PDF 378 KB] is Thursday, August 18, 2011 at 4 p.m. The awards ceremony will be held on the evening of Tuesday, October 11, 2011 at the new Ottawa Convention Centre.

The 2011 Ottawa Urban Design Awards celebrate projects built in the City of Ottawa that exhibit urban design excellence. The awards will honour exceptional projects built in Ottawa between September 1, 2009 and September 1, 2011. This is a biannual awards program.

Good urban design is how buildings, landscapes and adjacent public spaces function together to enhance the public realm. It includes the art of place making and designing the built environment to be appreciated and enjoyed at the human scale. This is not an architecture award.

The author of the winning submission of each category will receive an **Award of Excellence**, which acknowledges a project that achieves urban design excellence and meets the judging criteria. Other entries in each category will be eligible to win an **Award of Merit**. An important distinction between the two awards is that the winners of the Awards of Excellence will be forwarded to compete nationally in the Royal Architectural Institute of Canada's 2012 Urban Design Awards Program as representative of the City of Ottawa.
