- 1. How have our societal and/or professional roles evolved, what of the future? How can landscape architects be looked upon as leaders who bring a form of stability to this new landscape?
- 2. What are our responsibilities in working with others: professionals, politicians, and clients, and how can we ensure we are heard? What effective methods might we employ to achieve this and remain neutral and unbiased?
- 3. How can landscape architects take the lead among the design professions in responding to climate change in the projects they are involved in?
- 4. What are the roles and responsibilities of landscape architecture when we look at <u>Justice, Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion</u>? What is our responsibility in public education, engagement, relationship building, or consultation with the public, and ensuring underrepresented persons are heard?
- 5. How do landscape architects creatively assert the greater public good in community development after legislated changes caused unintended ripples in their ability to do so?
- 6. Landscape architect-led projects that have had a lasting ripple effect or impact on other developments or projects. How have you as a landscape architect considered ripple effects and treated them as an opportunity rather than a constraint?
